Online applications are invited with effect from **17.08.2022 (from 4:00 PM) to 23.08.2022 (up to 4:00 PM)** from Indian Nationals having permanent residence in Tripura for selection of candidates for recruitment to the post of "Post Graduate Teacher (For Class XI-XII)" through "**Selection Test for Post Graduate Teacher(STPGT)-Second Session 2022**" under Secondary Education Directorate, Education (School) Department, Government of Tripura. All posts are permanent and period of probation is 2-years. Subject-wise vacancy position is as follows:

NB: **Reservation for women:** There will be 33% horizontal reservation in the reserved category and 33% general reservation in the un-reserved category for women pursuant to GA (P &T) Department, Government of Tripura Notification vide No. F.23(17)-GA (P&T)/2022 dated 28.06.2022.

1. Essential Minimum Qualification:

- (a) Post Graduate in relevant subject/ allied subject (equivalency of which to be determined by equivalent committee) with at least 50% marks (or its equivalent) from recognized University and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) from NCTE recognised institution.

(b) Post Graduate in relevant subject/allied subject (equivalency of which to be determined by equivalent committee) with at least 45% marks (or its equivalent) from recognized University and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) from National Council for Teacher Education recognised institution { in accordance with the National Council for Teacher Education (Form of application for recognition, the time limit of submission of application, determination of norms and standards for recognition of teacher education programmes and permission to start new course or training) Regulations, 2002 notified on 13.11.2002 and National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007}.

OR

(c) Post Graduate in relevant subject/allied subject (equivalency of which to be determined by equivalent committee) with at least 50% marks (or its equivalent) from recognized University and B.A. Ed. / B.Sc. Ed. from any NCTE recognised institution.

NB: Relaxation up to 5% in the qualifying marks will be allowed to the candidates belonging to SC/ST/PH category.

2. **Age** : Up to 40 years as on **29.07.2022**. Upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST/PH and Government Servant provided that government employees belonging to SC/ST/PH category shall not get relaxation over and above general relaxation of 5 years available to them. Upper age limit is also relaxable for Ex-Serviceman (ESM) as per norms.

NB: NB:(i) 2(two) year age relaxation will be allowed due to COVID-19 pandemic for all category candidates as per memo of GA(P&T) vide No. F.23(11)-GA(P&T)/2022 dated 11.07.2022

(ii) Permissible age relaxation will be applicable for candidates from discharged ad-hoc 10,323 teachers as per memo of GA(P&T) dated 05.11.2020. (Candidates belonging to this category must click yes in the relevant field on online application form to get the benefit).

3. **Pay**: Rs. 26,025/-fixed per month(Group –C Non-Gazetted) being 75 % of basic pay (Level-10) of Tripura State Pay Matrix, 2018.
4. **Equivalency of a Degree**: Equivalency of a Degree (Post Graduate etc) will be ascertained by Equivalence Committee formed by Education (School) Department, for example whether or not M.Sc. Nuclear Physics is equivalent to M.Sc. Physics will be determined by Equivalence Committee. Candidates claiming equivalency of degree will be allowed provisionally to appear in the **“Selection Test for Post Graduate Teacher-Second Session-2022”**. Such candidate must apply to the Board within 5th September 2022 along with self attested photocopy of the Mark sheet of the degree for which the candidate is claiming equivalency. Application thus received will be forwarded to the Equivalence Committee for decision and decision of equivalent committee will be final.

If a candidate applied for STPGT and secures a mark enough to be recommended for recruitment, but the Equivalence Committee has given decision that she/he does not have an equivalent degree required for the post for which he/she applied, his/ her candidature will be rejected without further notification and his / her name will not be recommended to the concerned department for recruitment.
